Mecca and The Largest Clock

" The construction of the biggest clock in the world in the purest spot on earth is a dream come true for Muslims " said Atif Flemban who lives in Mecca. This big clock is located in the center of the holy city of Mecca, Saudi Arabia and is overlooking The Grand Mosque. Mecca is starting to be beautiful and shining with the clock is running during the Muslims fasting month of Ramadan on August 12. It is considered the largest clock in the world and its tower is expected to be the second tallest building in the world after Burj Khalifah in Dubai. Moreover, this clock is six times larger than that famous clock of London Big Ben. The huge bright clock is visible from more than 16 miles, thus it has become the fundamental landmark in the Alhijaz region. In fact, the amazing clock has four faces one in each direction and is covered with 98 million pieces of glass mosaic tiles. Only one of the clock's four faces has been completed and each face is inscribed with "God is the greatest" in Arabic. In addition, the clock is being built in a particular Islamic style of architecture and it has two lifts that will carry visitors to a balcony below the clock to enjoy a wonderful view. The Saudi Press Agency said " a huge golden crescent moon, 75 feet in diameter, will eventually rise above the clock on a 200 foot spire, from which some 15 beams will shoot up into the sky".

DOWNTOWN AQUARIUM

The shark is behind you! That is the truth when you are in the Downtown Aquarium. Imagine yourself under the ocean, what would be your feeling? . The Downtown Aquarium is a very interesting place for young people and especially for families. It's worth knowing some facts, the history and attractions that might make you want to visit the aquarium.

The Downtown Aquarium is located in downtown Denver on 700 Water Street. From I-25 traveling north, exit 23rd (exit 211), then follow the exit to the right where you will immediately see the aquarium on your right. It is near the 16th street mall and beside Six Flags and the Children Museum.

The aquarium was established in 1999. It cost the city of Denver about \$93 million. After years of losing money, the city decided to

sell the aquarium. The aquarium was bought by Landry's Restaurant in 2003. They redesigned and reopened it in 2005 and they changed its name from Colorado's Ocean Journey to Downtown Aquarium.

The Downtown Aquarium is an aquarium plus a restaurant. It has about 1 million gallons of water and houses more than 500 species of animals. These animals include freshwater fish from Colorado, as well as sea life from around the world. The animals in the aquarium are distributed among several tanks. The aquarium also houses tigers, sharks, birds, reptiles, amphibian, guitar fish, sea turtle, sawfish and many kinds of animals.

There are several areas in the aquarium. One of these areas is a restaurant aquarium which has about 150,000 gallons of water and offers sea food dishes with a

view of the aquarium. Other areas are an open tank where you can enjoy touching sting-ray fish. Moreover there is also a bar, gift shop and a ball room that seats 50 to 250 guests.

The aquarium offers a lot of activities for children and families. One of these activities is scuba diving in the tanks where there are a lot of fish in one spot. Also you can dive with the sharks. In addition, they offer the Sea Safari Summer Camp activity, Wild Dream Overnight activity, birthday celebrations and a lot of programs for children.

It is an amazing feeling to see the life underwater and to be very close watching what is going on under the ocean and learning about the animals. It is worth trying this adventure in the Downtown Aquarium.

The power of dark chocolate

A Boston study in the journal of the American Heart Association discovered the way to prevent heart failure with dark chocolate. According to them, having a chocolate once or twice a week could be lowering their risk of heart failure.

They looked at about 32,000 Swedish women between from 48 to 88 over nine years and they found that if they have dark chocolate once or twice a week (19-30g per serving) they can reduce the risk about heart failure by 32% and people having dark chocolate 1-3 times a month risk of heart failure by 26%. Therefore, the study suggests that the optimum condition is having dark chocolate once or twice a week.

According to the study, cocoa has a concentration of compounds named flavanols which help to lower blood pressure and protect against heart failure and dark chocolate has up to 75% of cocoa while milk chocolate has up to 25% of cocoa. That's why they recommend dark chocolate as a treat.

However, having dark chocolate everyday is not going to help you. Chocolates have a lot of sugar, fat and calories so lots of consumption causes problems such as a weight gain, diabetes and other adult diseases.

Dr. Mittleman, who is the study's leader and director of the Medical Center in Boston said,

"You can't ignore that chocolate is a relatively calorie-dense food and large amounts of habitual consumption is going to raise your risks for weight gain, but if you're going to have a treat, dark chocolate is probably a good choice as long as it's in moderation."
